

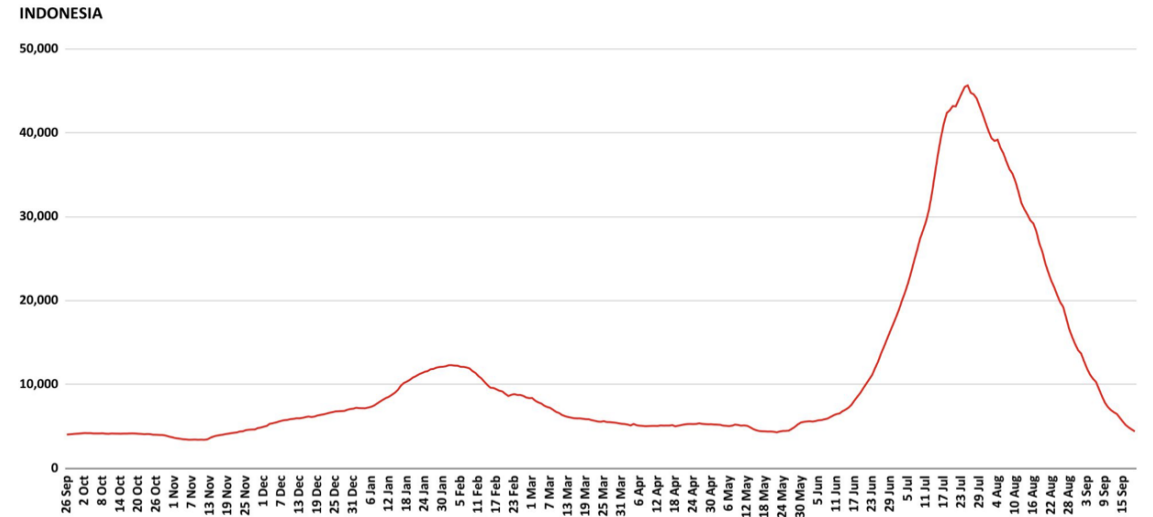

**Since January, 2021:**

*Limited face to face learning at school -- Schools that fulfilled all necessary conditions may reopen but not obligatory, subject to permissions from parents and local governments.*

### Teachers Sharing

Online sharing among teachers on varieties of learning deliveries



### Internet Quota Subsidies

Internet subsidies provided for learning activities to all students and teachers from ECE to HE

Emergency curriculum covered foundations and the most essential learning outcomes



### Student Assessment

Online assessment on regular basis as part of learning activities



### Alternative Learning Deliveries

Alternative deliveries through national television network TVRI, national radio networks RRI and online "Rumah Belajar."



### Sanitation and Health Campaign

Health protocol campaign and aids packages: masks, hand sanitizers, disinfectants and sanitation facilities



### Access to Internet Network

Computer packages to increase acces to internet network



### Modular Instructional Packages

Digitalized self-instructional learning materials for all learning outcomes for all subjects, some use LMS.

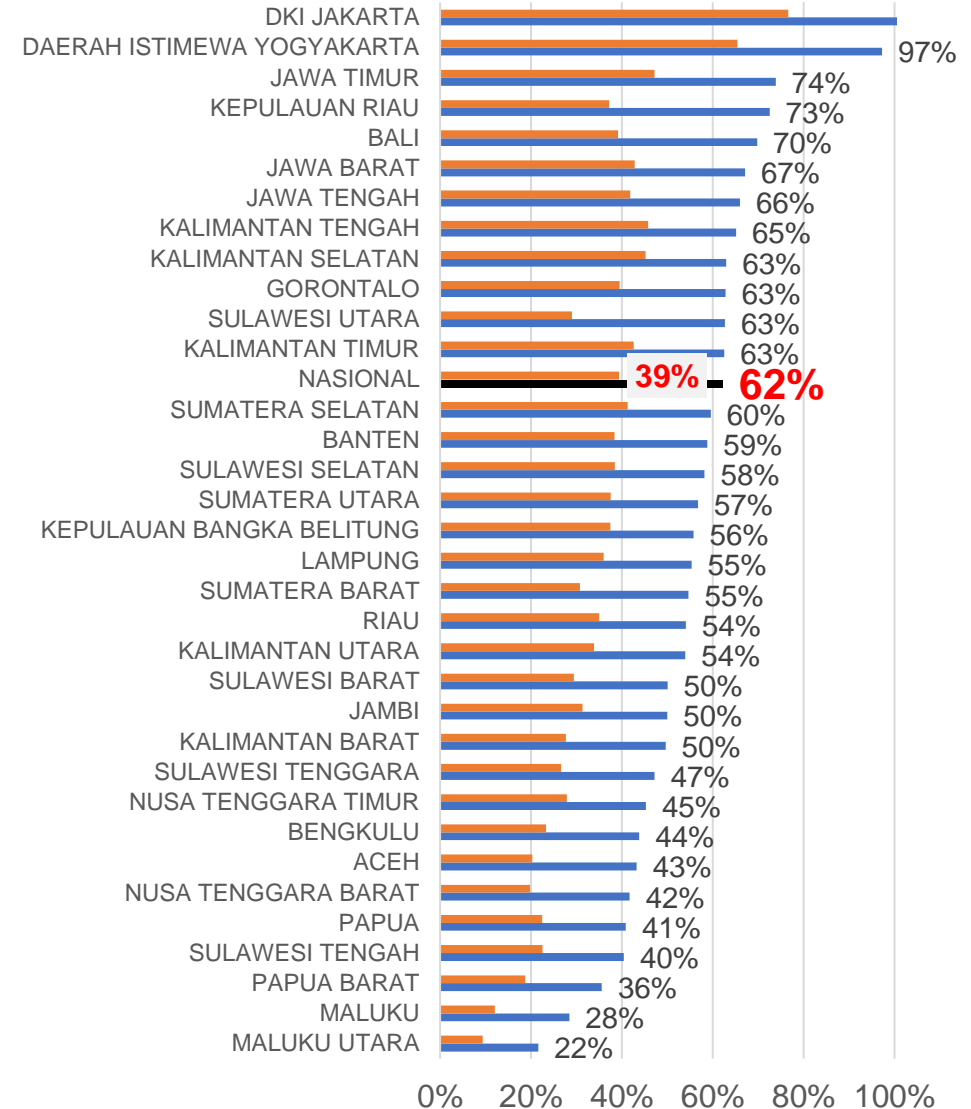
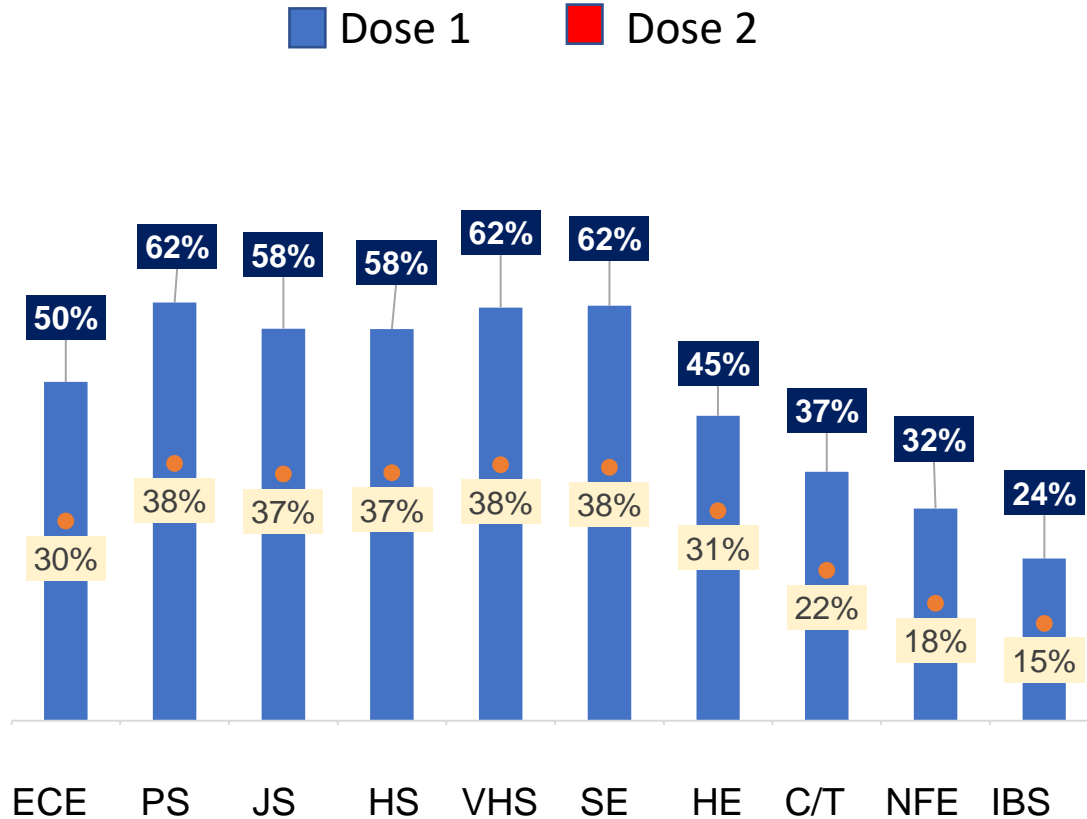


### Online Capacity Building and Webinars

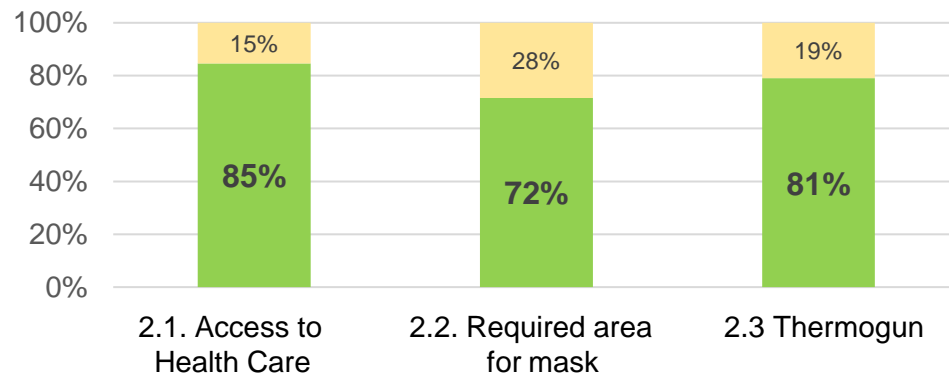

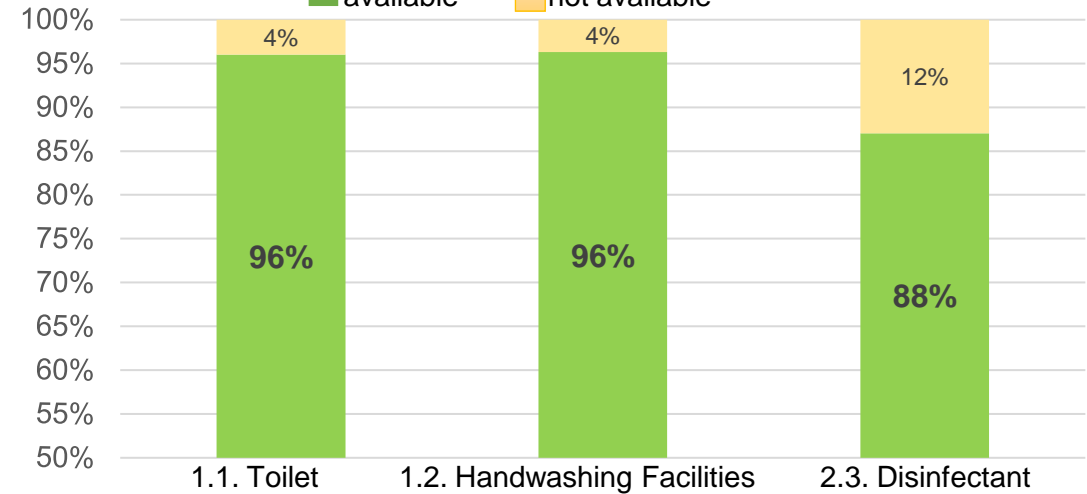

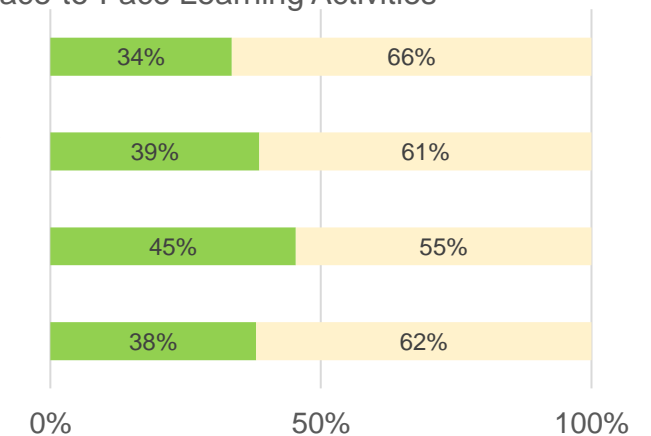

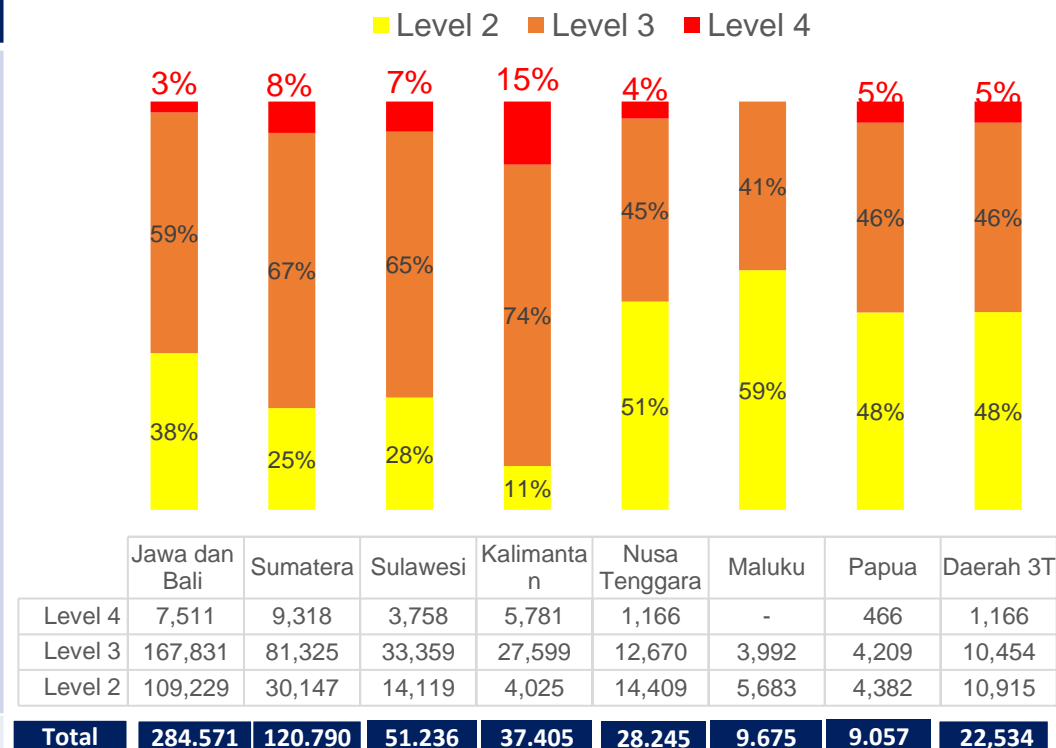

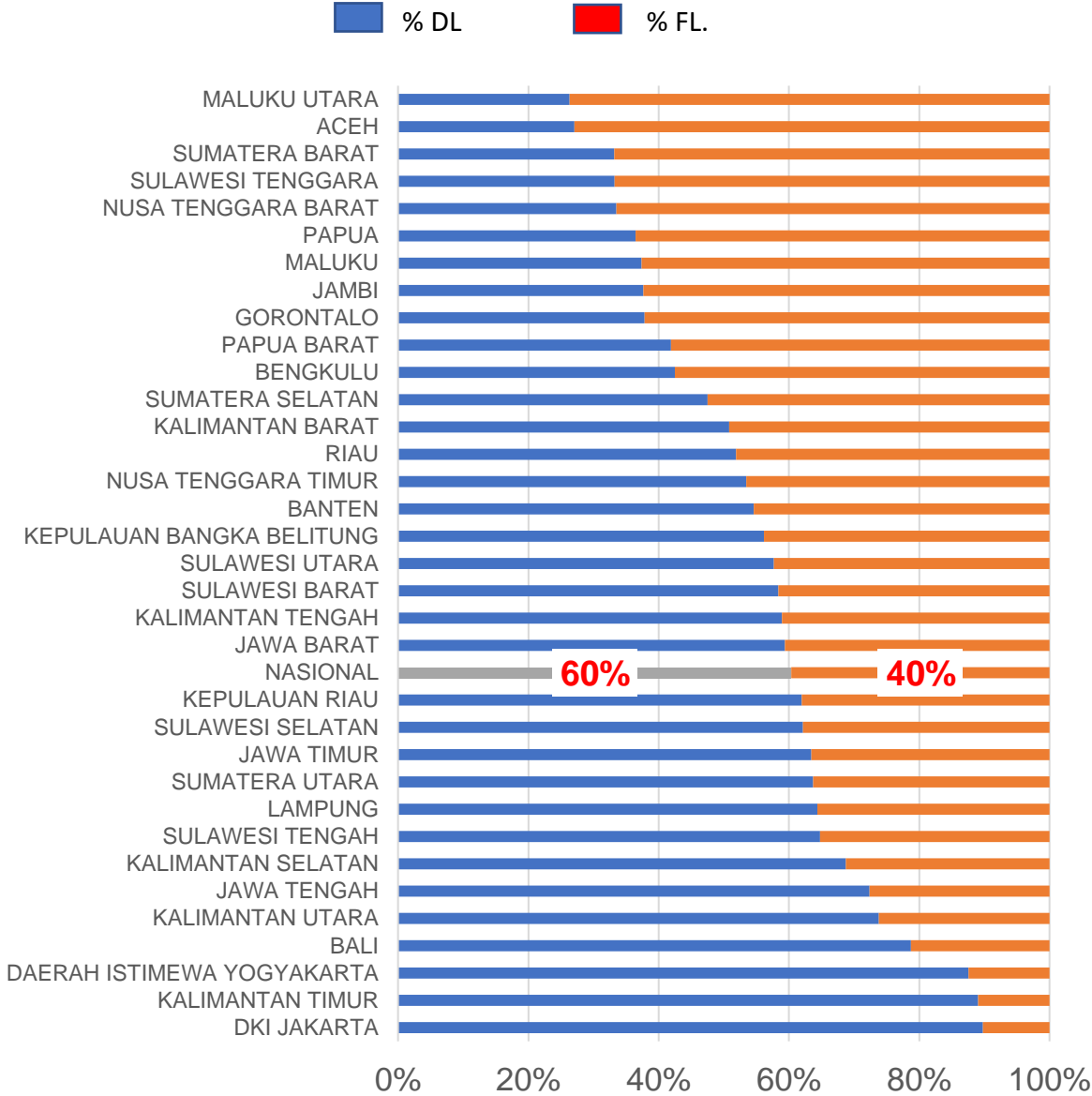

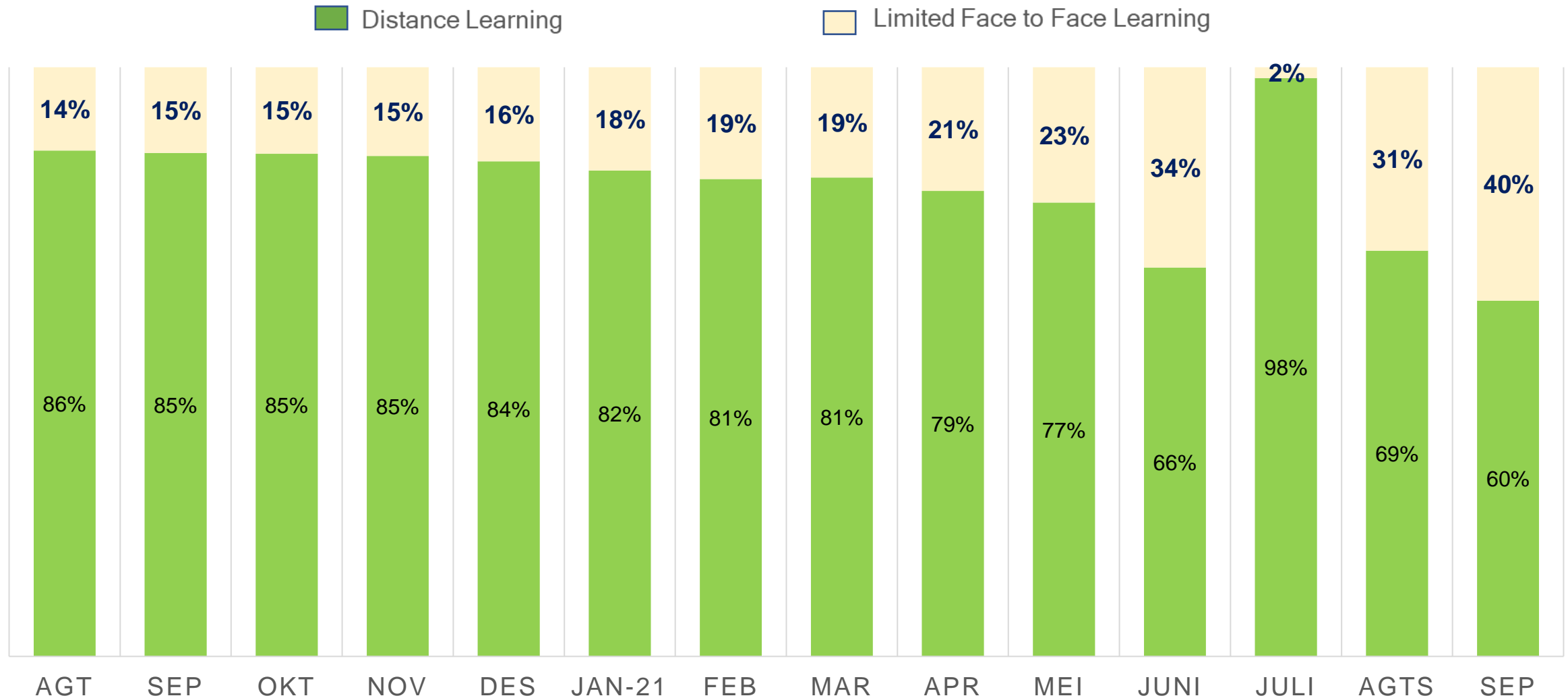
# Reported Implementation of Limited Face to Face Learning by Province

# Practical Experience: Readiness Indicators to Safe Reopening of Schools

1	<p>Availability of hygiene and sanitation facilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• clean toilet ;</li> <li>• handwashing facility with running water and soap or hand sanitizer and</li> <li>• disinfectant</li> </ul>
2	have ability to access health service facilities (local health center, clinic, hospital, etc)
3	apply in the required area to use cloth mask or translucent mask for those who have deaf students.
4	have <u>thermogun</u> (body temperature measurement).
5	<p>mapping member of education units who can't do activity in education units:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• have uncontrol medical condition (<i>comorbidity</i>)</li> <li>• no access to transportation that have possibility to apply physical distancing</li> <li>• have travel history from yellow, orange and red zone or contact history with confirmed COVID-19 positive person and not yet finish self-isolation for 14 days</li> </ul>
6	make agreement with education units committee related to the readiness of face to face learning. The process still need to apply the health protocol .

# Recommendation



Accelerate vaccination program for teachers and administrators, and for students above 12 years old,



Local education and health offices to verify and validate **the School Readiness Checklist** submitted,



Local transportation office to ensure the availability of safe transportation modes,



Local COVID-19 Task Force to keep campaign and educate the health protocols: wearing mask, washing hands, keeping safe distance, restriction of public and private gathering, and limiting domestic movement,



Active role from local government needed to ensure the success of limited face to face learning activities.
