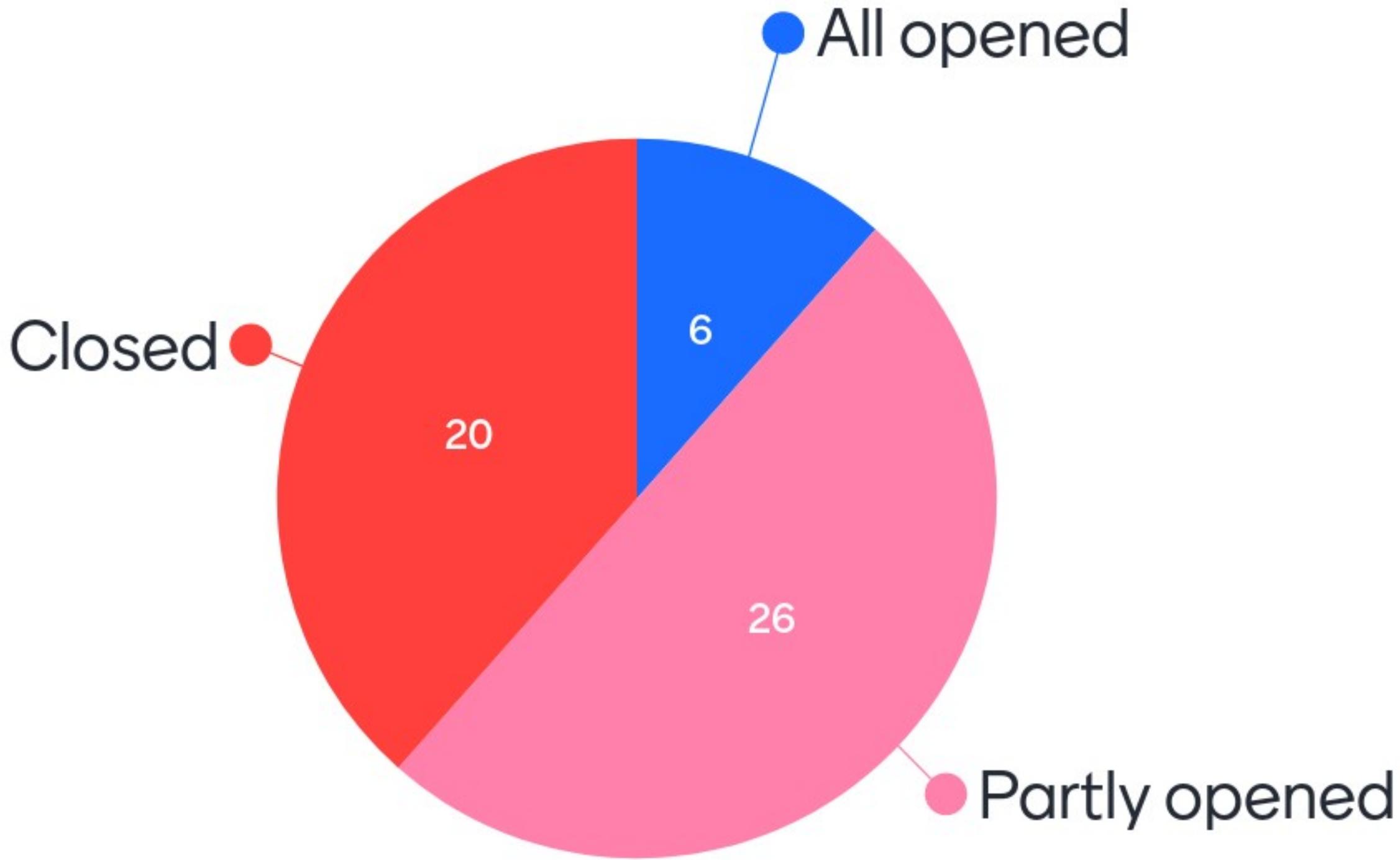

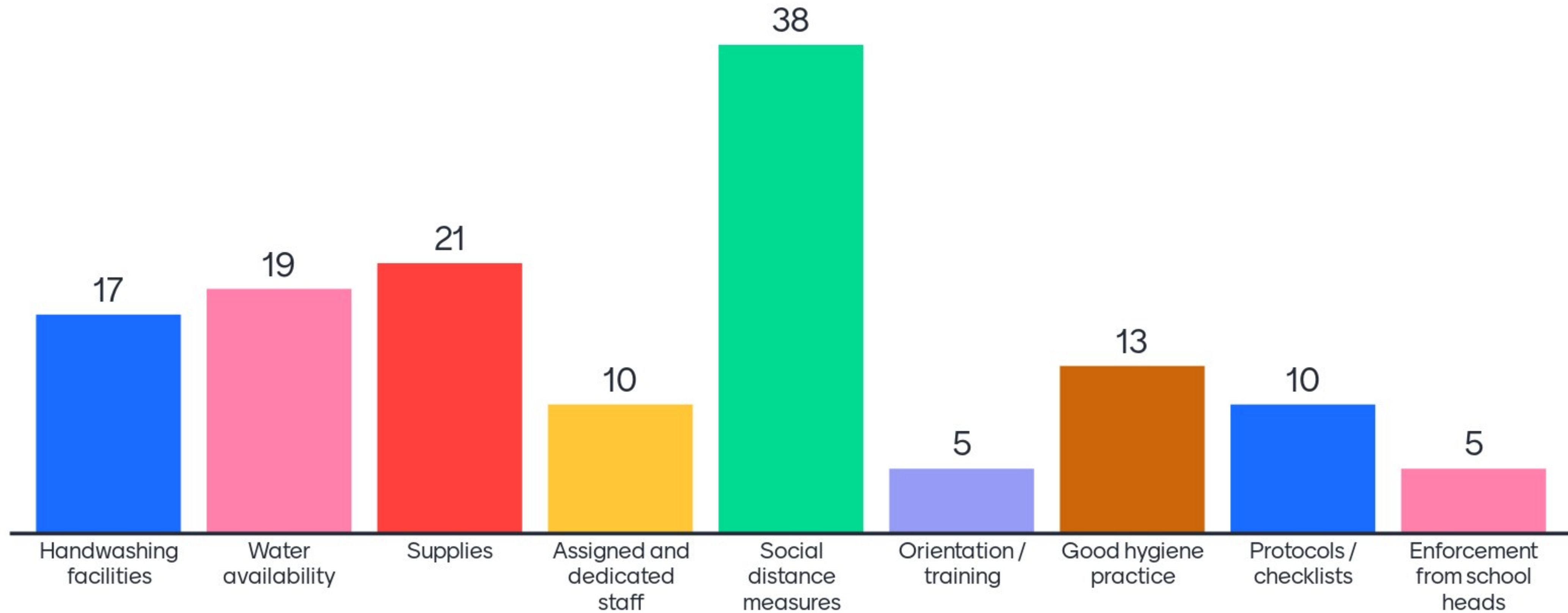

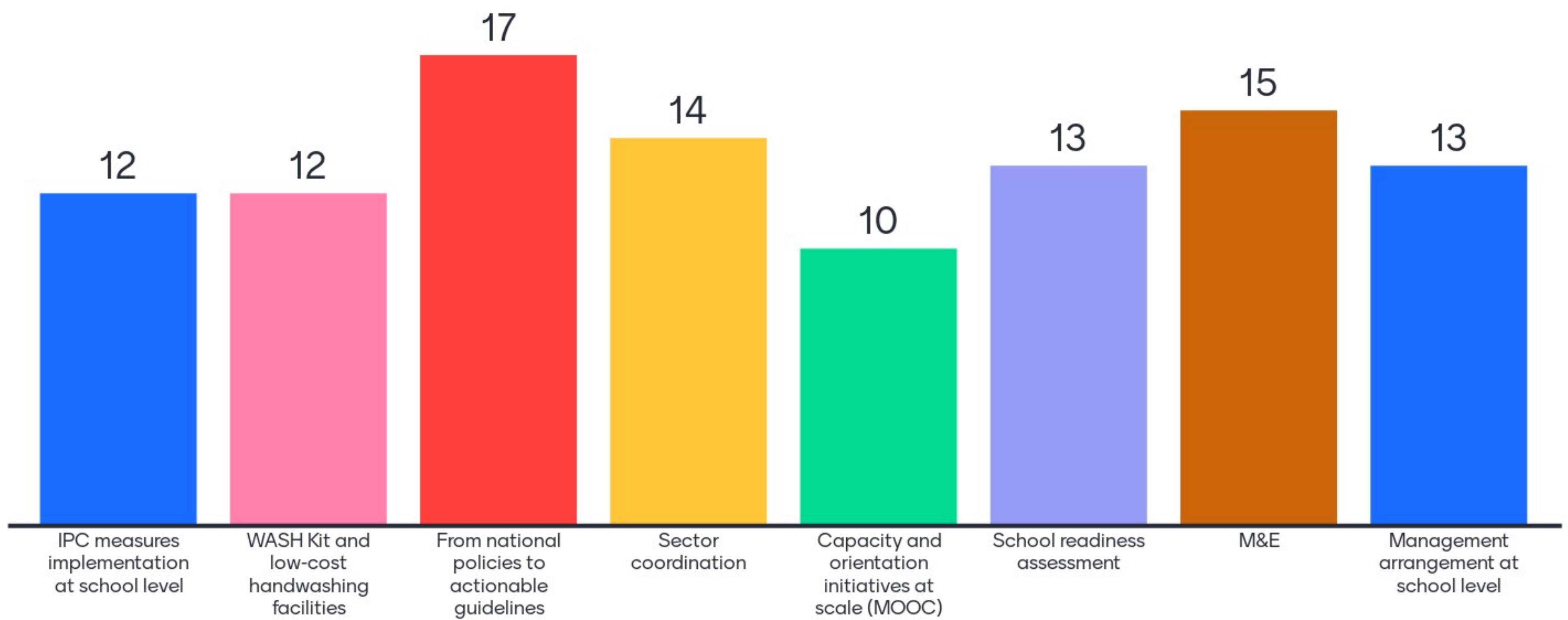
Transparency and accountability
