



School Readiness Checklist to Reopen (Limited) Face-to-Face Learning Activities

As Reported by **316.732 Schools/Education Units** (59%)









Recommendation



Accelerate vaccination program for teachers and administrators, and for students above 12 years old,



Local education and health offices to accelerate verification and validation of **the School Readiness Checklist** submitted,



Local transportation office to ensure the availability of safe public transportation modes,



Local COVID-19 Task Force to keep campaign, educate, and reenforce the health protocols in public: wearing mask, washing hands, keeping safe distance, restriction of public and private gathering, and limiting domestic movement,



Active role from local government is badly needed to ensure the success of limited face to face learning activities.
